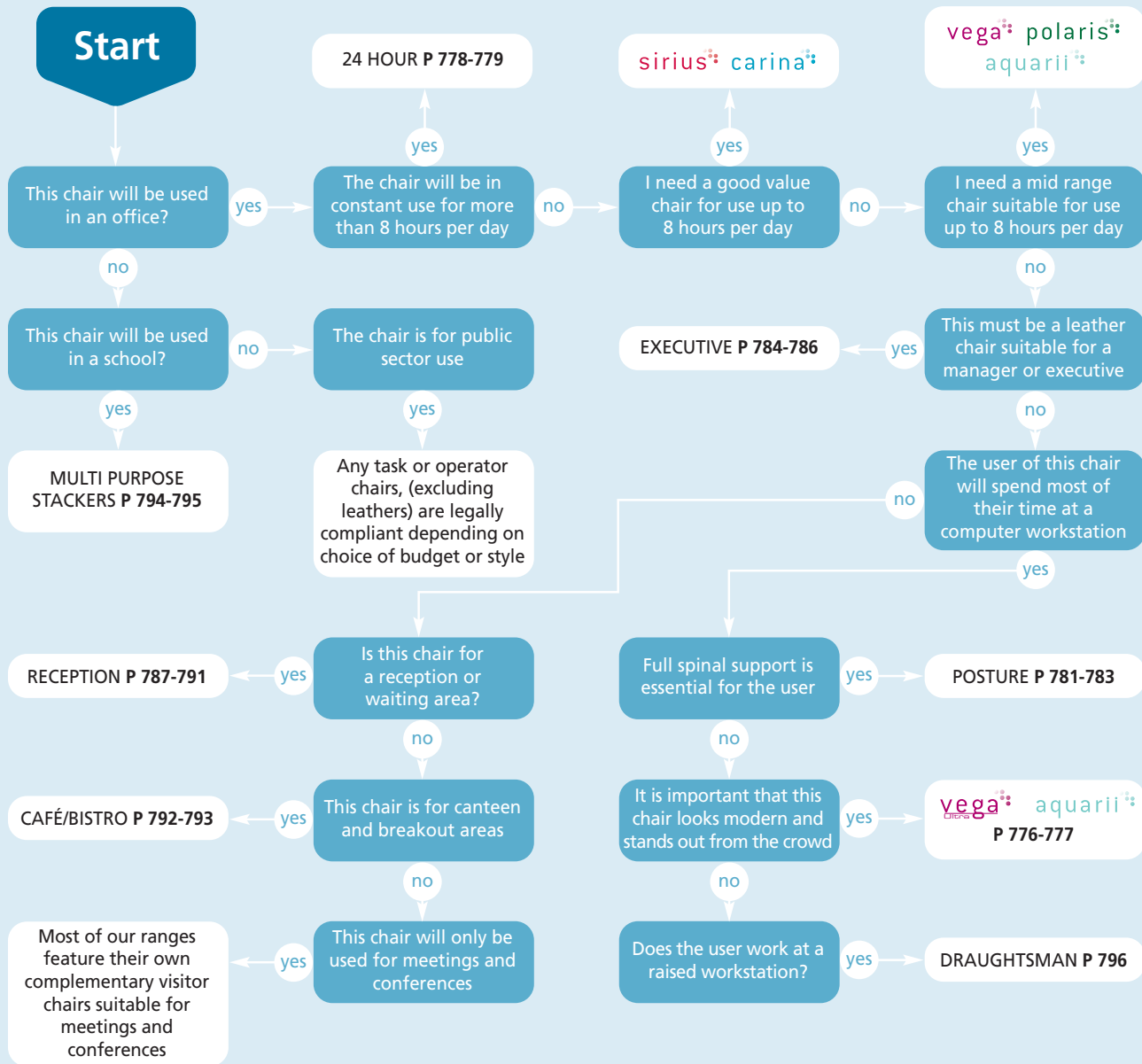


? HOW TO CHOOSE - Seating

Where to begin... *Choosing the right chair is not a decision that should be taken lightly, but when there are so many different shapes and sizes how do you know which one is right for you? Follow our easy to use guide and you will find the perfect one for you.*



These movement icons are used throughout this section to explain the features of each chair



Asynchro the seat and back will move up and down. The angle of the back and seat can be fixed or free float



Fixed back the seat will go up and down and the back will go up and down and in and out



Inflatable lumbar a pump allows you to inflate the lumbar support to best suit you



Knee-tilt a single lever locks and unlocks the tilt of the chair. The mechanism can also free float



PCB the seat and back can go up and down and the angle of the back can be fixed or left free floating



Stack chairs with these icons can be stacked to save storage space



Synchro adjusts the seat and back angles in a synchronised movement with a ratio of 2.5° back to 1° seat



Synchro tilt tension synchro action with seat slide and the ability to adjust the tension of the reclining movement



Tilt tension the seat and back and height angle can be adjusted. The tension of the tilt can be adjusted



Tilt tension plus the seat and back angle (and height) can be adjusted. The seat can slide in and out and the tension of the tilt can be adjusted



Lock tilt a single lever will adjust the seat height and tilt of the chair which can be locked or free float
